Marine Pollution Management Infrastructure in Danang, Vietnam

The scheme "Building up Da Nang into an Environmental City" was approved and issued by the Da Nang People's Committee in October of 2008. According to the scheme, the requirements for the quality of land, water and air environments around the city will be met, and thereby the health and safety of citizens, investors, and local and foreign tourists will be guaranteed. Since then, for the realization of the scheme, the city government has been focusing on constructing and upgrading infrastructure to effectively prevent environmental pollution in the whole city in general and the marine areas in particular. The presentation will introduce 4 key environmental infrastructure projects that the city has been calling for investment in the recent years, including (i) Sustainable sanitary landfill to energy system, Khanh Son landfill, (ii) Solid waste management for Da Nang city, (iii) Septage and sludge treatment facility in Da Nang city and (iv) Industrial waste water management.
