THE OBJECTIVES OF LUAS


- ✓ To ensure the water resources & environmental surrounding is in a manageable & sustainable condition;



Pelaksanaan Pelan Pengurusan Bersepadu

- 46. (1) Walau apa pun apa apa jua peruntukan lain dalam mana mana undang undang Lembaga-
 - (a) bolehlah menggubal dan melaksanakan suatu pelan pengurusan bersepadu bagi pemuliharaan dan pembangunan mampan mana-mana sumber air;
 - (b) hendaklah menasihati mana-mana pihak berkuasa awam, di dalam bidangkuasa mana sumber air atau bahagiannya terletak, mengenai pengurusan, pemuliharaan dan pembangunan sumber air itu;
 - (c) hendaklah melaporkan setiap tahun kepada Pihak Berkuasa Negeri mengenai kedudukan pematuhan undang-undang dan peraturan dan pelan Persekutuan dan Negeri atas semua sumber air di dalam Negeri;
 - (d) bolehlah menubuhkan jawatankuasa pengurusan kawasan tempatan dan kumpulan pemegang kepentingan untuk bekerjasama dengan Lembaga;
 - (e) memberi nasihat kepada Lembaga dalam penandaan keluasan rizab sungai dan zon perlindungan yang lain; dan
 - (f) boleh mengawalselia pembangunan mana-mana 4 empangan, takungan atau pengepengan pada mana-mana sumber air

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LEMBAGA URUS AIR SELANGOR

(2) Lembaga bolehiah, dengan kelulusan Pihak Berkuasa Negeri, membuat peraturanperaturan di bawah seksyen 127 bagi semua yang disebutkan di atas termasuk pengawalan mana-mana aktiviti pengubahan sumber yang diusahakan oleh manamana orang atau pihak berkuasa awam. The implementation of IRBM & ICM is in line with Section 46(1) and 127 of LUAS's Enactment 1999



CURRENT STATUS OF IRBM IMPLEMENTATION IN SELANGOR


- ➤ Selangor River IRBM Plan (2007-2012) has been reviewed to be implemented from 2015-2020;

- ➤ Klang River IRBM Plan will be developed by the year 2016




ICM PLAN











❖ State of Selangor is implementing an ICM program covering the entire coastline which consists of 5 districts with the length of 291km

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


LINKAGING AND HARMONIZING BETWEEN RIVER AND COASTAL MANAGEMENT

- Malaysian river basins and coastal zones are the most productive ecosystem in the country:
 - 1) houses majority of the population (human & natural activities)
- 2) represents a unique environment requires special attention in its planning, development and management
- IRBM and ICM had been treated as a separate entity previously.
- Unplanned and uncoordinated development of river basin and coastal zone can lead to the degradation of river and marine ecosystems health and this can be attributed to the management of the land and coastal zone as a whole.
- The IRBM and the ICM are essentially deal with the integrated management of river basin and coastal zone as a single interactive entity.
- Deals with the coordinated use and management of land and water resources and other natural resources and activities within the river basin and coastal zone, to optimize the use of these resources in a sustainable and productive manner.



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


